Should I get a Home Security System?

Though a home security system may seem like an expensive investment, it could help pay for itself, considering that you may get a discount on your homeowners insurance premium for having a system in place.

Safety First

When you think home security, you may only think burglar alarm. However, a fire alarm system is just as important. A fire that starts while you're away from home can result in losses that far surpass those of a break-in. Having a fire alarm built into your home security system will ensure a quick response in the event of a fire, whether you're home or not.

SMOKE DETECTOR MAINTENANCE

Smoke detectors are one of the most important safety devices you can install in your home. It's absolutely vital to test them regularly and replacing smoke detector batteries is critical to their usefulness and to keep your home and your family safe.

When selecting a smoke detector, keep the following in mind:

- Photoelectric units are better for smoldering fires—such as electrical fires in the walls—so they're ideal for kitchens and bathrooms where these fires tend to occur.
- Ionization units give the surrounding air an electrical charge and then measure whether the charge



remains constant or if a fire consumes the oxygen in the air. These units are better suited to areas where fires get out of control, such as a basement or near a furnace.

Use this guide to ensure smoke detectors are working:

- Press test button on the unit and wait for sound.
- Light a candle and hold it 15 centimetres below, so the heated air will rise into the detector.
- If the alarm doesn't sound within 20 seconds, blow the candle and let the smoke rise.
- If the alarm still doesn't sound, open the detector and clean the unit. Then, test the unit again.
- *If the detector still isn't working, it should be replaced immediately.*



IS YOUR HOME SAFE?

Disinfect your home after a virus.

Focus on the bathroom, kitchen and shared surfaces in the bedroom. Clean areas the sick person spent time in and things he/she touched, including countertops, faucets, and cabinet hardware. Pay special attention to hard surfaces where germs can survive, such as TV remotes and door handles. Disinfect sheets, pillowcases and other bedding. Clean electronic devices, such as cell phones and tablets.

Use the right products for each place—bleach for the bathroom, laundry sanitizer for clothing and bedding, and disinfecting wipes for many hard surfaces - **be sure each surface stays wet for 15 seconds to kill germs.**
